



CHICKEN AND BACON STEW

Serves 4

3 bacon rashers (chopped), medium carrot (chopped), 2 firm apples (chopped), 1tsp butter, herbs and spices to taste, 8 small chicken thigh fillets, medium onion (chopped), pepper to taste, cup of beer, 8 medium mushrooms (chopped).

Melt butter slowly in camp oven, add pepper, chicken pieces and bacon. Cook until bacon is brown. Add onion, carrot, apples and mushrooms and cook for 10 minutes. Make sure heat is medium add beer with herbs and spices to taste and cook for another 30 – 40 minutes.
Note: you can add any vegetable you like and you can serve with rice
